<p>Vv. 10-12 What about divorce and remarriage?</p>	<p>Jesus' Law</p> <p><u>Three exceptions to Jesus' restrictions:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Divorce & remarriage permitted for persistent adultery, Matt. 19:9. • Permitted when a nonbeliever divorces a believer, 1 Cor. 7:12-15. • Permitted, by extension, for those divorced before salvation, 1 Cor. 7:12-15. 	<p>Jesus restricted divorce & remarriage.</p>

Vv. 6-9 What about marriage?	Creation Law	Creation reveals God's <u>purpose</u> for marriage, v. 6 (Genesis 1:27). Creation reveals God's <u>plan</u> for marriage, vv. 7-9 (Genesis 2:24).
Vv. 10-12 What about divorce and remarriage?	Jesus' Law	Jesus restricted divorce & remarriage. <u>Three exceptions to Jesus' restrictions:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Divorce & remarriage permitted for persistent adultery, Matt. 19:9.• Permitted when a nonbeliever divorces a believer, 1 Cor. 7:12-15.• Permitted, by extension, for those divorced before salvation, 1 Cor. 7:12-15.
