vv. 17-21: *Jesus was betrayed by His Friend*

How Jesus Reached Out to Judas to the Very End

- ❶ Jesus washed Judas' feet (see John 13:1-11).
- ❷ Jesus reminded Judas of Ahithophel (v. 18 = Psalm 41:9).
- ❸ Judas was seated at Jesus' left, a place of honor.
- ❹ Jesus offered Judas renewed love & forgiveness, vv. 19-20.
- ❺ Jesus warned Judas of his awful fate, v. 21.
