The first person to come by and fill out a survey was a professor named **Sandy**. Sandy usually did not come through the hallway that we were in but because of the rain she took the inside walk right past our table. Sandy filled out the survey and we ended up having about a 10 minute conversation. Sandy had been in Marquette for about one month, she landed her first teaching job at NMU in the business department since getting her Ph.D., she is from Taiwan, she loves Jesus and was looking for Christian community.

Sandy said, *"I believe God had me walk inside today so that I could meet you."* I invited her to church and to a Bible study. She came to both and it's been so sweet to see our friendship blossom. Sandy has a desire to reach out to students and she said she would help us when we have an outreach to international students.

We have also had many conversation with students since having the survey on campus. We have talked to students who already embrace Jesus as their Savior, to students who claim to be atheists, to students who are integrating their Native American heritage with Christian truth, and the list goes on.

We are so thankful that God has led us to Sandy and to all of the students we have talked to this semester. We still have many to follow up with so we ask for your prayers that we would make connections with them and that God would lead them to saving faith.

Here are the results!

- 510 students and some faculty participated in the survey.
- 354 people checked yes or maybe on the survey.
- 156 people checked no that they weren't interested.
- Of the 156 people who said "no" – 34 said that they were unsure about their relationship with God, 23 said that they wanted to grow in their relationship with God, 5 said that they were searching for answers.

God is definitely moving in people's lives & hearts. You are an important part of seeing lives change.

Thank you for investing in these young men and women and in the faculty too.
