USING THE GIFTS WE HAVE

Christmas is a time where we remember the gift that God gave to us in sending Christ to earth to live a perfect life and die a sinner's death (my death). As I reflect on the gift that God gave to us in His son, my mind wanders to the gifts that I have been given in general – the natural abilities, the spiritual gifts, and the physical blessings (things) that God has given to me. Paul addresses the use of gifts to some degree in his letters to Timothy.

Paul had a special mentoring relationship with Timothy, a relationship that spanned years and saw Timothy move into a role of pastoring churches. In the midst of this relationship, Paul reminded Timothy to not neglect the gift that he had been given (1 Timothy 4:14) and then again to fan into flame the gift God had given to him (2 Timothy 1:6). Imagine if someone gave you your ideal headphones for Christmas. You took them, set them on your dresser, and never used them. That would be a waste, wouldn't it? Yes it would.

Similarly, Timothy had been given some gift or set of gifts and had not been using them, or at least not using them to the level that he should have been. Now,

these gifts were not just things that some person had given to him, these were specific gifts given to him by God for a purpose. He was to use them to lead churches, grow believers, and further the Kingdom of God.

While the example of Timothy is that he was not using the (presumably) spiritual gifts that he was given to the best of his ability, the same thing can be true of all the gifts that we have. God gives us many different gifts and we are to use them, to develop them, and to enjoy them. It was not by mistake that God made you particularly good at some particular thing; He did this so that He would be glorified through your using it. So use your gift. But don't just use it, find ways to build God's kingdom through using it. Get to know people through using your abilities and then share the truth of Christ with them.

In the spiritual sense, we are likewise to use our gifts to God's glory; we are to develop the gift; we are to enjoy the use of the gift. Paul outlines the gifts in Romans 12:6-8 as prophecy, service, teaching, exhorting/encouraging, giving, leadership, and mercy. If you don't know what your spiritual gift is, then let's spend some time to figure it out. It is incredibly important that we know what gifts God has given to us so that when we stand before Him, we can give account for how we used them to His glory.

We have been given a lot of gifts: Christ, natural abilities, spiritual gifts. Be thankful for them, use them, and glorify God through them.


